**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2024**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that Devon County Council has made the above titled order.

The order came into force on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2023 and would have expired on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

By direction of the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the order shall continue in force until 5<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until works have been completed, whichever is sooner.

No persons and/or horse riders shall proceed on the affected path except for access to land or premises on or adjacent to that length of path.

Public right of way affected:

**Bridleway No. 68, Ottery St. Mary for its entire length.**

There is no alternative route.

The closure is necessary in the interest of public safety.
